The next Open Enrollment Period for coverage beginning in 2015 will be November 15, 2014 to February 15, 2015.

Illinois Medicaid (also known as the Medical Card) does NOT have an enrollment deadline, and you can apply anytime throughout the year. Men and women ages 19-64 may now qualify for Medicaid depending on household size and income:

Household size:	You may be eligible for Medicaid if your <u>monthly</u> household income is less than:	You may be eligible for Medicaid if your <u>annual</u> household income is less than:
