 All Additional Staff: Carry pocket phone to be reached by all nursing staff Answer unit phone and call lights at nurse's station: take message if RN unable to speak with family Hourly rounding Check blood sugars on diabetic patients Fill cups with ice and set in freezer in nutrition room for nurses to grab and go for main med pass time (0800 to 1000) & (2000 to 2200) Distribute all meal trays in a timely manner Stock Linens as needed; At Lease Once per Day Check Ante Rooms and supply carts, clear out extra supplies, ensure Sani-wipes are stocked, gloves in every ante room Gather bathing items for nurses and place on isolation carts (gown, 2 towels, bath wipes, lotion, etc.) Help with ADL's: bathing and daily care, etc.; Night shift staff-perform baths Help settle new admits/Take out discharges when needed Clean and put up CAPR helmets that are not currently in use Exchange out Batteries on CAPR cart throughout the day Help take out Trash and Linen bags in Ante Rooms and Patient Rooms as needed 	Charge Nurse on COVID Unit making assignments
