Monoclonal Antibody Criteria & Outside EPIC Workflow

As a reminder, the criteria for receiving these monoclonal antibody drugs is as follows:

Individual must be within 10 days of symptom onset, not require hospital admission and have one or more of the following high-risk criteria to receive the drug:

- body mass index (BMI) ≥35
- chronic kidney disease
- diabetes
- immunosuppressive disease
- currently receiving immunosuppressive treatment
- ≥65 years of age
- ≥55 years of age AND have: cardiovascular disease, or hypertension, or chronic obstructive pulmonary disease/other chronic respiratory disease.

If an individual has received a monoclonal antibody treatment, they should not receive the COVID-19 vaccine within 90 days.

Outside EPIC Workflow: Provider's office should call the SIH St. Joseph Memorial Hospital Infusion Center at ext. 55315 and notify there is a patient that needs to be set up for an infusion. The scheduler will fax the provider's office a hard-copy order to complete and return. Once all necessary information is received, the patient will be scheduled.
