

CURRENT COVID-19 Guidance - last updated May 6, 2020

Guidelines for SCREENING In Person

SCREENER checks for PPE & screening instructions
(Hospital screeners check in with house charge)

SCREENER puts on mask and eye protection (goggles or face shield)

PATIENT/VISITOR presents

SCREENER immediately offers person a mask if not already wearing one. Ask patient to don mask before proceeding, (unless person physically unable to mask.)

SCREENER verifies if person is PATIENT or VISITOR

PATIENT _

HOSPITAL

- Take patient temperature and complete Patient Screening Form.
- Patients with no boxes checked should take completed Screening Form to registration to continue their visit.
- If any one box is checked, call House Supervisor to review screening for clinical accuracy.
- If House Supervisor verifies criteria, ask patient to leave and call COVID Hotline. Provide instruction card. Send positive Screening Form to registration for scanning.

AMBULATORY

- SCREENER: Take patient temperature.
 Write legal name & temperature on
 Patient Screening Form.
- 2. Hand screening form to patient and direct them to registration.
- 3. **REGISTRATION:** Complete Patient Screening Form and scan.
- 4. If NO boxes are checked, patient proceeds through visit.
- If patient has any box checked:
 Reschedule appointment following
 Video Visit guidelines and provide
 patient an instruction card to call
 COVID Hotline.

VISITOR

- 1. Take visitor temperature.
- If temperature is below threshold, follow Visitor Screening Guidelines to verify visitor is allowed to enter.
