CURRENT COVID-19 Guidance - last updated August 6, 2020

VISITOR Screening Guidelines

- Birthing Center, Pediatric, and NICU patients may have one designated support person cleared by Unit Supervisor.
- Emergency Department and Surgery/Procedure patients may arrive with one support person.
- Inpatient adults may have one visitor between 11a-7p. Shift Supervisor clearance not needed.
- Patients may have one support person cleared by House Supervisor available around-the-clock when a caregiver is integral to their care. (Example: Patients with developmental delays or those in need of support for emotional well-being.)
- End-of-life patients may have two visitors at any time cleared by Unit Supervisor.

OBSERVABLE or SELF-REPORTED SYMPTOMS and EXPOSURES:

o nausea

- X Fever greater than 100°F, or has mediated to treat a fever over 100°F in the last 4 hours.
- X Any <u>ONE</u> of the following symptoms, if <u>NEW</u> within the past <u>7</u> days:

o repeated shaking with chills

o cough o shortness of breath o sore throat o headache o muscle aches or pain

o runny nose o **vomiting**

o nasal congestion

- o loss of taste or smell o diarrhea
- X In the past 14 days, visitor has been closer than 6 feet for more than 15 minutes to a person confirmed to have COVID-19, and at least one person was not masked.
- Visitor is awaiting confirmation of a COVID-19 laboratory result. X

Visitor must by over the age of 18,

meet ONE of the categories in top box and NO criteria in bottom box before being allowed to enter.

Add visitor name to visitation log, and issue a visitor badge with instruction to wear mask at all times, and remain in the patient room with no access to other parts of the building (e.g. cafeterias).

If visitor is excluded from entry, offer them the number to the SIH Covid Hotline (844-988-7800) for symptoms, or contact security if visitor does not want to leave. Script: Current guidelines indicate it would help to protect our patients if you are not allowed entrance at this time. In our current state of caution we are not going issue you a visitor pass today.
