## **NOTE: If this is an ADD ON to an already collected respiratory (NP) swab (in the last 5 days)**

- Place order for appropriate lab order (IDPH, Reference Lab or In-house testing)
  - Call lab to verify they still have specimen and request to have an ADD-ON order placed

A Respiratory Virus Panel is no longer required and should now only be done if the Provider feels it's clinically necessary and should not be utilized as a determining factor for COVID testing.
