

## IDPH does NOT require an electronic authorization any longer. They are still expecting you to use the criteria below for an IDPH order to be placed.

NOTE: A Respiratory Virus Panel is <u>no longer required</u> and should now only be done if the Provider feels it's clinically necessary and should not be utilized as a determining factor for COVID testing.

## 1. IDPH Criteria for testing:

- First Responder with COVID Symptoms
- Healthcare Worker with COVID Symptoms
- Hospitalized Pt with Unexplained Pneumonia
- Staff or Residents of a Residential Congregate Living Facility with Clusters of Possible or Confirmed COVID

## 2. If they do not meet the criteria above, please place a Reference Lab Order for COVID

## 3. IF this is an ADD ON to an already collected swab (in the last 5 days)

- If NP swab has already been collected for a Respiratory Virus Panel
- Place order for appropriate lab order (IDPH or Reference Lab)
  - Call lab to verify they still have specimen and request to have an ADD-ON order placed
