SIH St. Joseph Memorial Hospital

SIH St. Joseph Memorial Hospital has been a fixture in the Murphysboro community for over half a century. It is a full-service, critical access hospital. Purchased from the Sisters of the ASC Health System, St. Joseph is the only SIH facility with a Catholic affiliation. The staff takes pride in the hospital's spiritual roots, which is evident in their daily approach to patient care. Employee and physician satisfaction consistently ranks in the 99th percentile. St. Joseph is an integral part of the SIH system, having evolved over time to become the regional provider of specialized outpatient services.

- 25-bed critical access hospital serving the community as an inpatient facility for primary care
- Regional Sleep Disorders Center accredited by the American Academy of Sleep Medicine
- Area's only coordinated infusion therapy program
- Comprehensive wound care center with hyperbaric therapy
- Home to an outpatient geriatric counseling program
- Area leader for outpatient endoscopic procedures
- Busy Emergency Department that is part of the Prairie STAT Heart Network

Trauma Center at SIH Memorial Hospital of Carbondale

In 2019, SIH Memorial Hospital of Carbondale received designation as a Level II Trauma Center. The hospital is now equipped and staffed to provide specialized care to victims of major traumatic injuries, such as a long fall or a farming accident. For the people of southern Illinois, this means they can receive care near home, rather than traveling to St. Louis or upstate.

A trauma center is not just a place for treatment – it is a comprehensive service that starts at the moment of injury and doesn't end until the patient returns to pre-injury function, or as close to it as possible. It also includes preventative components:

- Community outreach
- EMS education and collaboration
- Rehab partnership
- Advanced surgical care
- Modern delivery of surgical services (Acute Care Surgery)
